WHO / WHAT IS ASI?

Academic Services International is an independent test preparation company specializing in SAT / ACT test preparation. ASI was founded by experienced teachers who developed a very unusual test prep program that focuses on the test repetition and question recognition, not content and solutions. This unique focus produces dramatic score increases and has, as a result, spread by word-of-mouth to over 45 international and American schools in 30 countries around the world. Our mission is to provide a quality course, comprised of a very innovative methodology, scholastic excellence, and sound educational theory and philosophy. We combine all these to show students how to prepare a comprehensive and successful strategy for taking the SAT / ACT test. WHAT SETS US APART?

Content / Method:

- The SAT / ACT is a "how to" test. It is NOT a critical thinking test. Critical thinkers over think the test. They bring too many possibilities "to the table," spend too much time evaluating these possibilities, and then, because they now have so many possibilities to consider, are more likely to choose a wrong answer. (This is why very bright students do not get comparably high scores.) The SAT / ACT must be approached as a STANDARDIZED TEST find the CLUE in the question, find the match in the answer choices and move on.
- Other courses generally teach vocabulary and math. We do not. Except for vocabulary, students ALREADY KNOW all the content that is needed. Focus does not need to be on learning new content, just recognizing when to apply the content that has already been learned.
- It is the question that is important, not the solution to that question. This is a very repetitious test. Only a few types of questions are repeatedly asked. If the test taker solves one question but fails to recognize the other 4 or 5 that are exactly the same solution, scores will be minimized. Because the types of repeated question are few, the student only needs to learn the few types and then Ito earn to recognize that type each and every time it is repeated. The solution for each is exactly the same: if you know how to solve the one, you can solve every other one exactly like it! This minimizes the time needed to prepare for the test.
- The SAT / ACT is a very repetitious test. The student needs to be aware of this and then learn to recognize the receptiveness to be able to effectively "work" the test. It also involves good test taking skills which are no longer taught to students in school and, although many are just common sense, must be pointed out to the student.

Faculty:



We place a strong emphasis on the quality of ASI teachers. They are selected for their skills at teaching as well as intercultural strengths. Each is a retired New York State certified classroom teacher with over twenty-five years of established teaching experience. ASI Structure:

The ASI course is a 22 hour program, offered on the school premises over two consecutive weekends. Everything that is needed to know about the SAT / ACT - the what and the how - can be taught in 22 hours. Individual tutoring as needed is provided during the weekdays between formal session at no additional cost to the student. If any student wants to repeat the course in a subsequent session, in whole or in part, it is also free of charge.

Scores:

It is often believed that one cannot prepare for the SAT / ACT. Our statistics prove that you CAN prepare for these tests, substantially improving your test-taking skills and dramatically raising scores. Individual increases range from 100 to 700 points! Average scores range from 250 to 300 points. From time to time we check the relevance of ASI practice tests. in a controlled group. The average increase of those who took the ASI course was reported three times higher than those who did not take the course. Another school with a high PSAT base reported that the SAT test scores of those who did not take the ASI course went below the PSAT level by an average of 10 points. Those who did take the course on an average showed an increase of 130 points over the PSAT base. The correlation between SAT scores and the SAT practice score has ranged between 85 and 97%

The ASI Student Manual:

The student manual is the centerpiece of the ASI course. It was written exclusively for ASI in the context of the ASI method. This manual is not available commercially or through any other company.

Flash Cards / Interactive Online Practice / Highlighter

The course includes a set of flash cards to aid practice and review. Just because we can't be with students as they practice SAT tests, it doesn't mean they are on their own. They will be provided with answers and detailed explanations for ALL test questions for verbal and math sections of the *Official Study Guide* (available as interactive online practice). It is all they need to continue and finish practice for the ASI test method. But it is more than practice. Practice just for the sake of practicing, unless it is clear what has just been learned, is meaningless practice. Students become very good at perpetuating the same error. The color-coded explanations don't just provide the answers, but more importantly, a detailed explanation for why they should never have picked the incorrect answer they chose. Because students can lose as many as 200 points on these tests by missing key words that identify the questions and assure the correct solution, students learn to use a highlighter to condition the mind to find ALL these clue words.

Time Management Strategy:

Because the SAT / ACT is a timed test, speed is as important as accuracy on test day. The student only has a limited time during which to earn as many points as possible. It is crucial for a student to develop an efficient time management strategy for maximizing speed and personal strengths. During the course, we will help each student to recognize these factors and adapt individual strategies for continuing improvement.

Timed Practice Testing:


As part of the ASI course, students will complete a timed SAT practice test to determine their baseline score. Each section of the test is corrected and explained in the context of the ASI method. By completing an entire SAT test together, students learn the best strategies for continuing to practice on their own. And because the method for taking both the SAT and the ACT is the same,

Extra Help And Personal Attention:

Post Course Follow-up Facility:

Just as our teachers are available outside of class hours, they continue to be available after the course is over and they've returned home. The SAT / ACT is NOT the sole criteria for college admittance, but it is a significant one. It is the one part of the formula that can be changed immediately, unlike grades, rank or student profile. Good grades but a low SAT score raises doubt about student potential, possibly necessitating a more critical look at student records. Low grades with a high SAT score leaves room for the benefit of doubt. And the SAT / ACT score is a primary factor in determining scholarships and grants.

Just eliminating stupid errors can raise a score as much as 200 points. We teach test-taking skills needed to score. In essence, we demystify the SAT / ACT process.

Another common myth is that the SAT / ACT is hard. The truth is, it is the question that can be difficult, often written in lengthy and obscure passages or confusing terminology. The solution and answer are most often easy. Students are given the keys to demystifying and interpreting questions.



Students: The ASI method is a process, not rote memorization. Students must hone the test- taking skills being taught by practicing and mastering the method. This is achieved through practice tests and assigned homework. It is only by completing these assignments that students can know what has been mastered and what has not. At this time, mistakes can be recognized and corrected with the help of an instructor. The assignments are designed to force students to make the most common mistakes that are often made on the SAT / ACT, driving home lessons they will never forget. Better these mistakes are made with us than on the SAT / ACT test day.

Parents: After the instructor leaves, parents should encourage their child to continue to practice SAT / ACT type questions from the Official SAT Study Guide book as they have been taught. The final score your student can achieve will be directly proportionate to the amount of practice time he or she puts into these practices. We urge the parent to encourage the student to complete all assigned homework on time and to continue the SAT / ACT practice after the instructor has gone.
